Baptism at St Elizabeth's



We had a wonderful Sunday on the 13th of June when Delilah Washington, aged 13, and Raphael Washington, aged 11, were baptised here. Giselle, the Curate, had been to visit them prior to the service where they shared their faith and aspirations as Christians and their future plans. They made the decision themselves to be baptised with us which was all the more poignant because they had attended St Elizabeth's with their Great Grandmother, Jean Dolan. Jean was a very popular barmaid at the Greyhound pub in Ashley and had always been involved with St Elizabeth's. Jim Clarke, who read one of the readings, spoke of how Jean had been one the first

people in the village to make him welcome. Delilah and Raphael were able to chose their own Godparents who all came to support them on the day. They also chose all the hymns for the service (there was an amusing moment at the end when Rev'd Giselle was asked without prior notice to sing a solo)! Rev'd Giselle presented them with two shells; a representation of the Christian journey they had now embarked on. Overall, it was a very special morning where the Spirit moved bringing many blessings and laughter to all those present.

Community Café Project

Starting on the 4th of July after St Elizabeth's community service, on the first Sunday of every month, Jim and Ali and a few of the St Elizabeth's folk will be running a community café from 12pm to 4pm to raise funds to support people living in poverty. They will be serving Fresh Coffee, Tea and Cakes + Milkshakes from Ashley's very own Davies Dairy; it is Moolicious!
